VII. OFFENSES BY OR AGAINST MINORS

Chapter 9.68

CURFEWSections:

- 9.68.010 Designated.
 9.68.020 Persons with custody responsible to enforce.

9.68.010 Designated. Any person under the age of eighteen years who loiters or is found on the streets, alleys, public grounds or in or about any business or business house within the city after eleven p.m. on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of any week or after twelve midnight on Friday or Saturday of any week, unless accompanied by his or her parent, legal guardian or the person having custody of such minor, is guilty of loitering by minors. (Added during 1976 codification).

9.68.020 Persons with custody responsible to enforce. No parent, legal guardian or person having the custody of any boy or girl under the age of eighteen years shall knowingly or wilfully allow or permit such boy or girl to be guilty of loitering by minors. (Added during 1976 codification).

VII. WEAPONS

Chapter 9.76

CARRYING WEAPONSSections:

- 9.76.010 Deemed guilty when.

9.76.010 Deemed guilty when. Any person who carries a concealed revolver, pistol or other weapon on or about his person, or a razor as a weapon, or who, in a threatening or boisterous manner, displays or flourishes any deadly weapon, is guilty of carrying concealed weapons. (Added during 1976 codification).

Chapter 9.80DISCHARGING FIREARMS*Sections:

9.80.010 Unlawful.

9.80.010 Unlawful. It is unlawful to discharge any firearm in the city; provided that this section shall not be construed to prohibit any officer of the law to discharge a firearm in the performance of his duty nor to any citizen to discharge a firearm when lawfully defending his person or property. (Added during 1976 codification).
